Purpose of Annual Action Plan: The Annual Action Plan presents a detailed strategy for the use of CDBG, HOME, ESG, HOPWA and Continuum of Care Supportive Housing Program competitive grant funds expected to be received by the County during Local Fiscal Year 2010 to implement eligible activities in achieving fifth year objectives of the County's *Consolidated Plan: FY 2006 – FY 2010*. The Annual Action Plan also includes proposed amendments to previous Action Plans. In addition, the Annual Action Plan includes Anne Arundel County's definition of *affordable rents*, which applies to the CDBG program.

Public Comments on Annual Action Plan: Copies of the Draft Annual Action Plan for LFY 2010 will be on file at the office of Arundel Community Development Services, Inc., the County's Office of Minority Affairs and Human Relations and Anne Arundel County Public Libraries on April 25, 2009. Oral and written comments received by or before 12:00 noon on May 26, 2009 will be considered and changes made if such changes are deemed appropriate prior to submitting the final plan to HUD on or about June 1, 2009. A summary of all comments, with reasons provided for any comments not incorporated, will be included in the Annual Action Plan submitted to HUD.
